WHAT IS UPWARD BOUND?

Upward Bound is a pre-college program, serving 75 low-income, first-generation college-bound high school students (grades 9-12). Upward Bound offers a variety of services to students during the school year and the summer.

During the academic year, students...

- Meet on campus every Saturday morning to attend college-preparation classes, receive tutoring, mentoring, and other services
- Receive tutoring at their schools during lunch or after school
- Participate in community service activities at least once a month
- Attend cultural activities, such as Jazz games, performances by the Utah Symphony, etc.

During the six-week summer program, students...

- Participate in a one-week academic field trip
- Live in the dorms on campus
- Attend hands-on classes (math, science, literature and composition, foreign language, and more)
- Participate in community service and cultural activities

Upward Bound is a great experience for...

- **Education students who need a senior project**
- **Secondary education students who have little experience with diversity**
- **Anyone who wants to gain experience working with youth, instructing in a classroom, or writing their own curriculum**
