Activity Waiver Facts:

- You must apply for a scholarship/tuition waiver on your WSU student portal to be considered.
- If you are offered and accept an Activity Waiver from the WSU Theatre Arts program you MUST also register for 2 section of Theatre Practicum each semester.
- You MUST be a full-time student (minimum of 12 credit hours).
- You MUST maintain a 2.5 G.P.A. to retain your waiver from semester to semester, even after your first semester and your first year.
- You MUST audition/interview each December and March to retain your waiver from year to year.
- You can only receive a waiver for a total of 8 semesters.
