Remember, taking an average of 15 credit hours per semester facilitates timely graduation. The Associate of Science (RN) Program is competitive. On average the program receives 5 to 6 applicants for every available position. 64 are admitted for each fall, spring and summer starts (192 over the year). It may take longer than one year to complete all prerequisites and additional support courses. In some situations it may take completing an AS Degree in Health Science or an AS Degree in General Studies before being admitted.
