Notes: Admittance to the Musical Theatre Major is contingent upon successful completion of the Pre-Major Core Courses AND by successful audition. The program audition may be attempted concurrently while enrolled in the Pre-Major Core. Transfer students will be evaluated on an individual basis.

* Pre-major core courses: THEA 1063, THEA 1043, THEA 1030, THEA 1220 and THEA 1075 (taken twice) and DANC 1100 or 1200 or 1500

THEA 1223 Stage Makeup and two of the following technical courses are required: THEA 2012 Stagecraft, THEA 2022 Costume Fundamentals, THEA 2032 Lightening Fundamentals or THEA 2580 Computer Software for the Theatre. **Students should consider which design course they plan to take and take the appropriate technical prerequisite course.
