 Level 1 = ENGL 0900  
 Level 2 = ENGL 0955 or ENGL 1005  
 Level 3 = ENGL 1010  
 Level 4 = ENGL 2010 or ENGL 2015  
 \*grades of C or better required in all courses

**Math Course Placement**

Level 1 = Math 0950  
 Level 2 or 3 = Math 0970 or MATH QL1035 (recommended)  
 Level 4 = Math QL1030 (recommended) or MATH QL1040 or MATH QL 1120  
 Level 5 = Math QL1050, Math QL1080 or Math QL 1090  
 \*grades of C or better required in all courses
