### Follows an Academic Semester Schedule

- 15 weeks of coursework
- Scheduled class times on campus and Zoom
- Assignments have due dates
- Requires completion of General Education requirements

- Clinical modalities
  - Computed Tomography (CT)
  - Diagnostic Medical Sonography
    - Cardiac
    - Medical
  - Interventional Radiology

  - CT/MRI combined
  - Nuclear Medicine
  - Radiation Therapy
  - Women's Imaging (Mammography)

*Clinical modalities complete 24 hours of clinical education each week*

### Tuition

- Campus Cohort
  - Utah residents pay tuition based on traditional undergraduate [tuition and fees](#) established by the university
- Regional Cohort
  - Non-Utah residents pay a discounted flat rate tuition of \$3000.00

- No scheduled class times
- Online delivery
- Requires completion of General Education requirements
