Student Selection General Information

- Grades are the biggest part of the selection process, especially Anatomy & Physiology Prerequisite courses.
 - Average Cumulative GPA of accepted students is 3.5
 - Average grades of prerequisite courses are A and A-
 - Prerequisite courses are ***weighted heavily!***
- For the interview process, it is ideal for a candidate to obtain observation, job shadowing, or volunteer experience at Radiology Departments within hospitals.
 - Additional resources are found at arrt.org or asrt.org.
 - If unable to gain experience in a Radiology Department, any direct-patient experience may help.
- Additional consideration is given to:
 - Previously qualified applicants who were not accepted
 - Associate's Degree or higher
 - Any 3 Medical Certifications
- Ensure the most recent semester grades are listed on your transcript.
- Students may apply to multiple Radiologic Technology locations. However, many Outreach locations give preference to students living in the area or surrounding areas.
 - A separate and complete application including fee, reference forms, and transcripts must be submitted for each location.
