A Certified Cardiographic Technician is a healthcare specialist with expertise in conducting ECGs, Holter monitoring, stress tests, and procedures pertaining to the cardiovascular system. They collaborate closely with nurses, physicians, and other healthcare professionals to assist in the diagnosis, treatment, care, and recovery of patients with health-related conditions.

The Cardiology Technician Proficiency Certificate (EKG) prepares students for the Cardiac Credentialing International (CCI) certification in both Cardiographic Technician and Rhythm Analysis.
