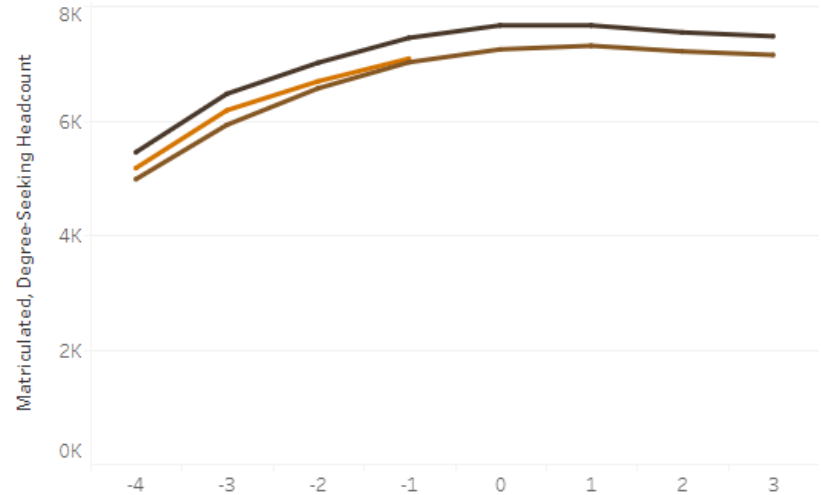

What's Weekly Enrollment Dashboard?

- Open Registration Enrollment Reporting
- Point-in-Time Comparisons
- Student Headcounts, FTE/SCH, Semester to Semester Persistence
- University, College, Department
- Various other characteristics and demographics

Enrollment Trends



Couple of key measures...

Matriculated, Degree Seeking Students

- What are they?

The quintessential college student that most people think of when they think of a “college student.” They are students are declared into a degree-granting program, out of high school, and enrolling in credit bearing classes.
- Why do we tracking them?

Institutional KPI – account for something in excess of 98% of campus course enrollments

Budget-Related Full Time Equivalent (FTEs)

- What are they?

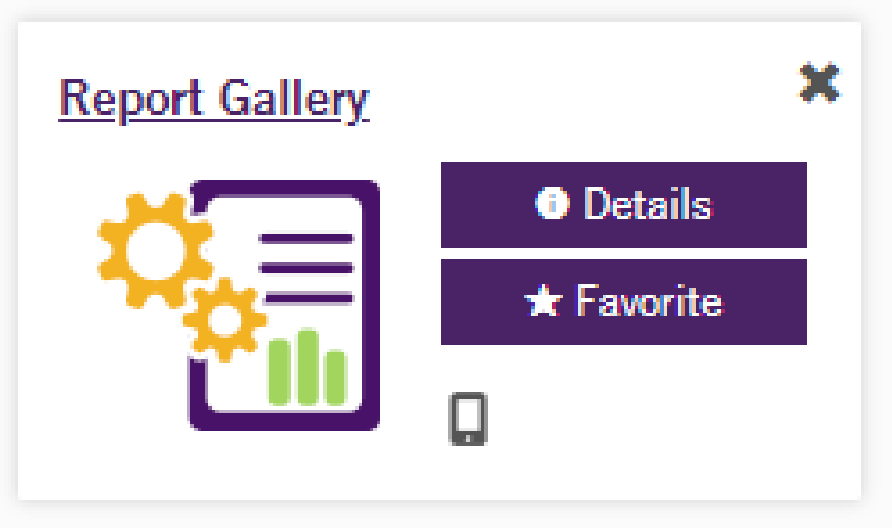
Standardized measure for describing how many students are enrolling in courses at a WSU. Based on the number of student enrolling in a course and the course’s credit hour weight.
- Why do we track them?

This enrollment measure directly links to state support and is a lead indicator for other important financial measures.




