Fragments - Shards of a Sentence

Every sentence needs at least one IC.

A Fragment is an incomplete sentence that typically occurs in one of the following ways:

- 1. Missing the Subject and/or Verb
- 2. A Phrase not attached to an IC
- 3. A Dependent Clause not attached to an IC

Sample Fragments (and how to fix them)	
Missing Subject/Verb	<i>Opened the door for me</i> . (Who?)
(Add S or V)	A gentlemanly ninja opened the door for me.
Phrase	He ran through the woods. <i>Remembering the first time he was there.</i>
(Attach to IC)	He ran through the woods, <i>remembering the first time he was there.</i>
Dependent Clause	<i>Before the penguin let me ride him.</i>
(Attach to IC)	Before the penguin let me ride him, I had to read it a good book.
