- Amount varies year-to-year
- Full-time student
- Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better
- Student with a disability with a declared major in English or the Social and Behavioral Sciences
- Must submit an essay describing involvement in student leadership and /or clubs and organizations.

- Amount varies year-to-year
- Student with a disability
- Cumulative GPA of 2.5 or better
- Must submit an essay addressing how this scholarship will help further your academic goals

# SCHOLARSHIPS FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES

## Application Checklist

- New students complete the online scholarship application process through WSU Scholarship Office. February is the priority deadline, but students can apply at any time.
- Continuing students verify and update their scholarship information via the WSU Student Portal.
- Check Wildcat Mail via the WSU Student Portal for all available scholarship application information.
- Contact SSD for specific scholarship information and deadlines. Scholarship forms and deadlines can be found on the SSD website, [www.weber.edu/ssd](http://www.weber.edu/ssd), under "Forms."
- Submit scholarship application information and documentation verifying disability status to SSD by given deadlines. Some scholarships require registration with SSD prior to application, so plan ahead!
- Regularly check Wildcat Mail for information about scholarship selection.

In order to be eligible for any scholarships, students **MUST** complete the WSU General Scholarship Application. Completion of this application by the priority deadline allows for communication between interested students and SSD.

Scholarships will be awarded prior to the start of Fall Semester. Students who have completed the General Scholarship Application and are eligible for a particular scholarship will be notified through Wildcat Mail via the student portal. All interested students must complete an application at Services for Students with Disabilities (SSD) and supply necessary paperwork outlined by the criteria for each scholarship. This application is in addition to the online General Scholarship Application through the WSU Scholarship Office.

All applicants will be required to verify disability status by meeting with SSD and providing necessary documentation. This documentation is highly confidential and will be protected to the full extent of all relevant laws and regulations. For guidelines regarding documentation of a disability, please visit the SSD office or website.

Requirements and due dates vary for each scholarship and are subject to change. Scholarship funding varies year to year, so please check the SSD office regularly for updated information.
