

2024-2025 Early College BELIEF Scholarship Application

Although high school students (including Early College students) are not eligible for federal or state financial aid, Weber State University and its generous donors have a dedicated fund intended for Early College students to attend WSU at a reduced cost. We thank these donors for their contributions that make scholarships for Early College students possible. This is the application for the President's Council BELIEF Scholarship.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Attend the required Early College New Student Advising Appointment after being admitted to the Early College Program.
- Complete mandatory New Student Orientation.
- Achieve and/or maintain a High School and WSU cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0.
- Provide documentation of financial need (Free and Reduced Lunch, high school waivers, or FAFSA)
 - OR Submit an essay indicating need without the above sources.
- Be a legal U.S. citizen and have established Utah residency

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- If you haven't already done so, submit Weber State University's online Scholarship Application. (**Note: The Early College Program cannot act on your Early College Need-based Scholarship Application until you have submitted WSU's online Scholarship Application.**)
 - Submit the Early College Scholarship Application with your Dual Enrollment Advisor.
- Complete the Early College BELIEF Scholarship Application and submit it in one of the following ways.

- If you qualify for the Free and Reduced Lunch Program, submit your documentation of eligibility.
- If you do not qualify for the Free and Reduced Lunch Program or FAFSA, submit a one-page essay and any supporting documentation to qualify without direct financial need.
- Applications and all documentation are due by the Friday before Fall or Spring semester begins.

Students must re-apply each academic year to be considered for of these funds.

AWARD DETAILS

- Selection and final determination of need comes from the Early College Scholarship Committee.
- The Academic Early College scholarship will apply to student balances before the BELIEF Scholarship.
- The scholarship consists of 2,000 dollars of funds that can be used to pay for tuition, any student fees, and books during the current academic year.
 - Funds are equally split between Fall and Spring semesters; totaling 1,000 dollars each term.
 - Any monies not used in a semester are forfeit and do not carry over into subsequent terms.
 - This award does not pay beyond 100 percent of tuition, fees, and books.

To avoid late fees, you must log into your WSU student portal to accept the award and you must pay all remaining tuition and fees by the Friday before the semester begins, if needed.
