25 of the 28 Criterion were met. One was Partially Met, and two were Not Met. The Accreditation Review Team recommended Full Certification and indicated the program is in "Substantial Compliance".

Although not an accreditation requirement, the review committee suggested learning outcomes be reviewed more frequently.
