Program evaluation demonstrates that students have achieved each <u>end-of-program student learning outcome</u> and each <u>program outcome</u>.

There are School of Nursing (SON) program outcomes and End of Program student learning outcomes:

SON Program Outcomes

- o **Outcome** #1: 80% of School of Nursing students will graduate from their programs within 150% of the stated length of the program.
- Outcome #2: 80% of School of Nursing graduates seeking employment will be involved in role related professional practice within 6-12 months of graduation as reported on the SON Alumni Survey
- Outcome #3: 80% of those students who take certification exams will pass on the first attempt

- Program Completion Rates
- Employment rates 6 months after graduation
- o MSN-NP annual APRN Certification rates DOPL licensure
- o Tracking and Trending of MSN Educator and Executive who choose to take role specific certification examinations

- o **Patient-centered Care**: Recognize the patient or designee as the source of control and full partner in providing compassionate and coordinated care based on respect for patients' preferences, values, and needs.
- o **Teamwork and Collaboration**: Function effectively within nursing and inter-professional teams, fostering communication, mutual respect, and shared decision-making to achieve quality patient care.
- o **Evidence-based Practice**: Integrate best current evidence with clinical expertise and patient/family preferences and values for delivery of optimal health care.
- O Quality Improvement: Use data to monitor the outcomes of care processes and use improvement methods to design and test changes to continuously improve the quality and safety of health care systems, including participating in healthcare policy.
- o **Patient Safety**: Minimize risk of harm to patients and providers through both system effectiveness and individual performance.
- o **Informatics**: Use information and technology to communicate, manage knowledge, mitigate error, and support decision-making.

The MSN End of Program Student Learning Outcomes (EOPSLO) will be measured annually through the following methods:

- o Refer to Course Maps (Standard 4) for alignment of Course outcomes/units and assignments to SON/Program Student Learning Outcomes.
- o Student will report obtainment of MSN End of Program Student Learning Outcomes at or above a 3.0/5.0 on the EOP Survey
- o 90% of students will receive a minimum on a B- or above for aggregate coursework (**Course Grades**)

Systematic plan for program (SPE) evaluation tool reports aggregated data, analysis of data, and program responses to the evaluation data with reference to ongoing program development, maintenance, or revision will be completed maintained and annually by October of each year.
