## INSTRUCTOR CREATED VIDEOS

Pre-record short lectures using [Kaltura](#) and ask students to interact through the integrated [Annoto](#)\* discussion tool.

## CANVAS DISCUSSIONS

Build threaded Canvas [discussions](#) based on a unit-related question, reading, or video. Students can reply using text, audio, or video.

## COLLABORATIONS

Ask students to work in small teams on a Google Doc using the [Collaborations](#) tool in Canvas.

### Notes:

\*Students can submit self-recorded or screen-recorded videos (up to 3 mins) instead of text comments.

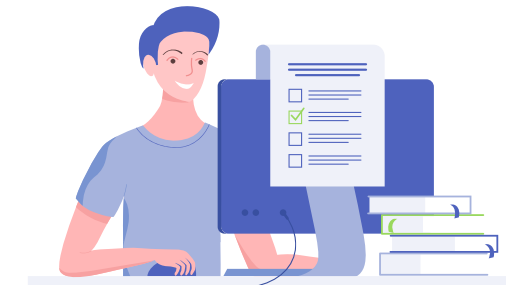
\*\*Create a T/F or multiple choice quiz in Annoto through Canvas Assignments (added as an external tool).
