

Starfish Referrals

The following referrals are currently in Starfish:

Referral	Description
Academic Advisement	This referral is to connect students to their academic advisor to help with selecting courses, connecting to campus resources, and help students from orientation to graduation.
Academic Peer Coaching	Coaches are available to help students develop effective learning and study strategies. Coaching sessions focus on topics such as test-taking, note-taking, time management, and textbook reading and can be adapted to students' specific needs and interests.
Career Services	Use this to refer a student to Career Services for major exploration, employment opportunities, resume writing, internships, etc.
Center for Community Engaged Learning	The Center for Community Engaged Learning (CCEL) engages students, faculty and staff members in direct service, civic engagement, and community research to promote civic participation, build community capacity, and enhance the educational process. We help students develop collaborative, reciprocal relationships with the community and thus better prepare them to be engaged citizens.
Center for Multicultural Excellence	The Center for Multicultural Excellence offers advising in applying for WSU, FAFSA, and scholarships. The center provides peer mentors and advisors who can help students with personal advising.
International Students and Scholars	The International Student and Scholar Center advises and assists international students with their personal, cultural, and academic adjustment to WSU.
Money Management Center	Can help with questions about budgeting, saving, loans, credit card debt, paying bills each month, or building wealth.
Nontraditional Student Center	The Nontraditional Student Center is here to help meet the needs of students who are over 25, married/divorced/widowed and/or a parent.
Peer Mentoring	The Peer Mentor Program under Access and Diversity connects students to their peers at WSU. Peer Mentors address issues like sense of belonging, navigating campus resources and developing interpersonal and intrapersonal skills. Refer students to the Peer Mentor Program when they need additional personal support, help making connections, encouragement in their college commitment/motivation, or simply need help with topics like goal setting, time management, imposter syndrome, social identities and more.

Referral	Description
Student Support Services	Student Support Services is a space designed to help students who are first generation, have disabilities, are low income, and are working toward their bachelor's degree. SSS offers such services as tutoring, book loans, grant aid, computer lab and study rooms for the students in our program.
Tutoring Referral	FREE tutoring for WSU students is available for a variety of subjects. Academic Support Centers & Programs offers drop-in and appointment tutoring as well as online tutoring. Students can meet with a tutor on the Ogden Campus, at the Davis Campus, or at the West Center.
Veterans Services	Use to refer students to the Veterans Services office.
Wildcat Scholars Referral	Use this referral to have an advisor from the program follow-up with students interested in Wildcat Scholars. For complete details on the program refer to https://www.weber.edu/wildcatscholars/
Writing Center	FREE tutoring is available for all WSU students writing for any class or project, including digital compositions. The Writing Center under Academic Support Centers & Programs offers face-to-face tutoring by drop-in and appointment to students on the Ogden and Davis campuses.
