ADDENDUM I

Major-Specific and Transfer Pathway Articulation Agreement Between Salt Lake Community College and Weber State University Health Administration

1. PARTIES. This Major-Specific and Transfer Pathway Articulation Agreement (the “Agreement”) is entered into by Salt Lake Community College (“SLCC”) and the Weber State University (“WSU”) (each a “Party” and collectively the “Parties”). By entering into this agreement, the Division of Allied Health in the School of Health Sciences at SLCC, and the Department of Health Administrative Services in the Dumke College of Health Professions at WSU, agree that the courses identified below will be accepted as equivalent in transfer.
