## Departmental Acceptance Policy

Students declare their program of study upon institutional admission, but must meet the departmental requirements for program acceptance. WSU's Department of Child and Family Studies will accept students to Early Childhood Education according to the following parameters outlined by the WSU Catalog of 2023-2024.

- *A grade of "B-" or better in HFST courses*
- *Cumulative GPA of 2.75 or higher*
- *A minor is required. In lieu of a minor, a specialization of 12 credit hours may be substituted as approved by the faculty advisor*
- *Students must apply and be accepted to the Teacher Education Program. – See Addendum for requirements*
  - *Prerequisite courses include: ENGL 2010 (grade C or above), MATH 2010, COMM 1020 or 2110 (grade B- or higher), and EDUC 1010.*
  - *The program has a competitive admissions process.*
  - *Student must apply the year prior to attending Weber State*
    - *January for Fall Semester, September for Spring Semester*
